

## Family Policy Alliance of Wyoming Candidate Report Card

Thank you for considering our Candidate Report Card as you go to the polls and vote this year.

We assigned candidates a grade based upon their voting record *or* their response to our questions. We graded each candidate based upon their agreement with the values of Family Policy Alliance of Wyoming in three categories: Life, Religious Freedom, and Family Values. We will show you how many times they agreed with our values in each category and provide you an overall grade at the end.

For each of the three issues we show the number of times the candidate agreed with our position versus the number of bills or questions covering that issue (for instance: 6/7 means that the candidate agreed with our position six times out of seven bills or questions).

Incumbent candidates running for re-election are graded based upon 18 bills from the 2021 and 2022 legislative sessions. The actual number of those bills that any given candidate voted on differs because some bills were only heard in one chamber or because a candidate was officially excused from a vote. Co-sponsors of bills were credited with an affirmative vote on that bill, even if that bill did not actually come up for a vote in their chamber and the final votes in committee were counted for bills that did not pass out of that committee.

## Questions asked of new candidates

The Issue that each question addresses is shown in [brackets] after each question.

Do you agree with this statement: “From the moment of conception, the preborn child has a fundamental, individual right to life that cannot be infringed”? [Life]

Would you have voted Yes or No on House Bill 92 Abortion Prohibition-Supreme Court Decision from 2022? [Life]

Will you uphold legislation that keeps taxpayer dollars from going to organizations that promote and perform abortions, including indirect funding through Medicaid? [Life]

Will you oppose, vote against, and/or veto research, and funding of research, that destroys or relies on the destruction of human embryos? [Life]

Will you oppose, vote against, and/or veto the legalization or promotion of physician-assisted suicide? [Life]

Recently, activists in several Wyoming Cities have been pushing city councils to pass sexual orientation and gender identity ordinances. Will you oppose, vote against, and/or veto adding “sexual orientation,” “gender identity,” or “gender expression” to the protected classes of race, religion, age, sex, and ancestry in local or statewide laws? [Religious Freedom]

Will you support legislation to prohibit government from discriminating against an individual, organization, businesses, or religious organization based on their beliefs about marriage, sexuality, and religious freedom? [Religious Freedom]

Will you support legislation that would prohibit organizations or boards from withholding accreditation or professional licensing because the program believes or teaches, or the license applicant believes or graduated from a program that teaches, that sexual relations should be confined to marriage between a man and a woman, or that biological sex is immutable? [Religious Freedom]

Will you support legislation that would require governmental entities to designate multiple-occupancy public restrooms and locker-room facilities for use based on a person’s biological sex? [Religious Freedom]

Do you believe that public schools should confine participation on sex-specific sports to those of the same biological sex? [Family]

Will you vote to protect the right of professionals to discuss all alternatives when helping persons with unwanted same-sex attractions or gender-identity issues. [Religious Freedom]

Do you support limiting Public Schools in their discussion of sexual practices? [Family]

“Would you vote to refuse federal school-lunch funds if acceptance requires sexual orientation and gender identity non-discrimination statements and policies?” [Family]



Will you vote to protect the right of public-school students to reference their faith in graduation speeches and at other school-related events? [Religious Freedom]
